HOME OF THE DREAM

California United Strikers FC is a professional men's soccer team in Orange County, CA. We are a founding member of NISA(National Independent Soccer League). With more than half our team born and raised in Orange County, we are locally focused and determined to represent the passionate and informed soccer fans of not only this country but specifically this county.

The club plays at Championship Stadium in Irvine, CA. The stadium holds 5,000 fans and is located in the heart of the GreatPark. Its central location in Orange County and immaculate facilities make it the perfect location for Cal United Strikers to call home.

Club owner, Bronwyn Capriotti and her husband Pete, have lived in Orange County for 40+ years. While raising their four kids, they put them in many sports, one of which was soccer. As their children grew, they found themselves enamored with the game of soccer. Pete coached several of their kids' teams and Bronwyn even had a very short stint as a referee. Their youngest son, Duncan, plays for the club. As Duncan progressed in his college soccer life, Bronwyn and Pete became more aware of how many great players fell through the cracks of professional soccer after college. With one year left of eligibility in college, Duncan got a chance to play in England and he and his wife moved there. During his year in England, Bronwyn and Pete visited several times to watch him play and were astounded at the way soccer was treated there. In almost every town they visited there was a stadium, whether large or small, for the local team. They saw the way the townsfolk flocked to the games and formed real bonds around the team and the players. The local boys had a way to follow their dreams and the fans were given what they wanted. When they returned to America, they continued to see a real demand for an outlet for players like Duncan to follow their dreams and pursue professional soccer.

With their passion for the sport, they set out to create a solution to the problem they saw. The first piece of the puzzle was getting a General Manager with extensive contacts and experience in the soccer world. They reached out to Michael Collins who had coached their three boys. Michael has enjoyed an incredibly successful professional soccer career in the various American pro leagues, including the NASL, MISL, NPSL, and USL, in addition to being selected as a US National team member in 1988-1989. This combined with his over twenty years of coaching experience have made him an indispensable part of the club.

Bronwyn, Pete, and Michael worked together tirelessly to make their joint vision come true. After a few trials and tribulations, California United Strikers FC was born. Once they amassed a team of highly skilled and professional level players, they needed to find a like-minded coach who would help to push the team to the next level. After an extensive search, they found Don Ebert.

Don has been the Director of Coaching for Strikers FC Irvine for over 25 years, and now serves as the Technical Director for both the Strikers FC Irvine, the top youth soccer club in the Orange County area. Under his leadership, the club has captured numerous Cal South State Titles, Far West Regional, and National Championships, while developing several high profile USMNT players in Bobby Wood, Benny Feilhaber, Christian Ramirez, Steven Birnbaum, Jonathan Bornstein, and many more!

His experience, passion, and soccer mentality make him a perfect fit for Cal United Strikers. With his help, we will not only give players a platform to be seen and follow their dreams, but also provide our fans with exciting quality soccer to watch.

Founded in 2009, Chattanooga Football Club strives to build community through the world's game. Our mission is to use soccer as a tool to build strong relationships – across age, race, creed and socio-economic status – for the greater good of our city.

Founded in 2012, Detroit City FC has established itself as one of the most talked about soccer teams in North America. Our club motto, Passion for Our City, Passion for the Game, evokes the three ideas the grassroots organization was built upon: to satisfy the demand for soccer in downtown Detroit, represent the city in a positive light, and build community through “the beautiful game.”

In an era when sports teams are defined by billionaire owners and millionaire players, we are a club with 5 founders and thousands of owners. The COVID pandemic put everything the club built in jeopardy; no “smoke delay” could match this darkest hour for Le Rouge.

Offering to sell a portion of the club may have been a desperate move, but it was also a rare opportunity for die-hard believers in community-based soccer to upgrade their passion to co-ownership status.

And while the struggles of life in a pandemic continue, there is a fresh sense of hope at Detroit City FC. In 2021, alongside the professional NISA men’s side, Le Rouge is launching a women’s first team (UWS) and reserve side (UWS2), a men’s U-23 side (MWPL) as well as growing its youth affiliate reach and academy system, all while taking to the airwaves as the first soccer team in Michigan to broadcast a season’s worth of matches statewide.

THE MICHIGAN STARS FOOTBALL CLUB (MSFC) is a history rich soccer club that has enhanced the lives of both youth and adults through sport. MSFC was created from a vision to bring top notch, high quality soccer to local communities. In working towards this goal, MSFC continues to instill the importance of teamwork to its members and fans alike as the platform from which MSFC effectively grows its community involvement, business partnerships and fan base to create a thriving, family friendly entertainment hub in Metro-Detroit.

The Michigan Stars FC is a professional soccer team currently participating in NISA (National Independent Soccer Association). The National Independent Soccer Association is a professional men's soccer league in the United States. The league is in the third tier of American soccer and began play in 2019. Michigan Stars Sports Center is an 80-acre soccer complex that contains 23 outdoor fields as well as an 118,000 sq. ft. indoor facility containing one full size 11v11 field.

The vision of Michigan Stars FC owner George Juncaj added a men's u23 development team, a women's pro-am team, indoor/outdoor facilities, and now the addition of a youth soccer club. The Michigan Lightning (Rochester Soccer Club) and Michigan Revolution, with their combined 3,000 soccer players in all soccer programming, have partnered with the Michigan Stars. The two clubs involved will rebrand their teams as Michigan Stars Lightning and Michigan Stars Revolution with the two clubs combining their highest level players forming Michigan Stars Elite. The partnership will begin fall of 2021. Tryouts for the new Michigan Stars Elite will take place on June 12-13, 2021 at the Michigan Stars Sports Center (formerly Total Sports Park) in Washington Township, Michigan. While speaking about the youth partnership, George Juncaj stated "We started meeting in June with local soccer clubs and I am excited for the partnership that we have formed with the new Michigan Stars Elite. It's exciting for youth players and coaches to have direct access to the professional players and staff and then having the ability to watch them compete during games. I want to create an opportunity for a six year old to dream and have a goal of playing professional soccer with the Michigan Stars."

We are looking forward to working with youth players from Michigan and develop their game so they can make the professional team.

The Michigan Stars FC pro-am women's team will begin to play in United Women's Soccer for the Summer of 2021. The team will primarily consist of college athletes nationwide with an emphasis placed on players from Michigan. Future plans will also include players from our newly formed youth club creating a competitive pathway from youth to adult.

The Michigan Stars FC U23 development team will begin to play in the Midwest Premier League in the Spring of 2021. The goal of the U23 team is to work with youth, college, and other young players to learn and develop under the tutelage and guidance of the Michigan Stars. The U23 team will have an opportunity to practice with the professional team and advance to the professional team when skills mature. Soccer players from a newly formed Michigan Stars youth club will be encouraged to try out for the development team.

The Maryland Bobcats Football Club was founded in 2009. Based in Montgomery and Prince George's Counties in Maryland, it is a fully minority-owned club with a majority minority roster. Maryland Bobcats FC has a "one family" mentality. From the youngest player to the most experienced, youth teams to First Team, players support, push and encourage each other to play the right way. Finally, we have chosen to use Football Club because of what we’re steadily moving towards, to bring San Diego Football and its valued players to the world.

Our colors are as simple as the game itself. A game where one team must score just one more goal than the other. Black and white also represent both the darkness (challenges) of sports and the light (victory). The telescope represents the club’s long-term vision and commitment to the region, along with its goal of developing local football talent and helping young players achieve their dreams of playing international soccer. It also symbolizes the club’s connection to the city’s long-standing commitment, described as Semper Vigilans, which means ever vigilant, on the city seal.

Beyond all football norms, we want to fully immerse ourselves in the culture, subcultures and the magic of community that make up football. We too, come from very different places and since, have played all over the world. But for many of us, our love for the game began in the very same place — the streets.
